Skirt option: Gray Donnelly’s skirt or sports skirt worn to the knees with opaque tights or black leggings worn with solid black dress socks. No anklet socks. 3. Pants option: Gray Donnelly’s pants, solid black or solid brown belt, black dress socks. 4. Black long-sleeved Prout sweater or Prout sweater vest. Dress uniform may be worn anytime.
